BFSNA General Meeting Minutes, February 10, 2009

The meeting was called to order by Andrew Parthum at 7:05 p.m.

The minutes of the January meeting were approved.

There was an abbreviated discussion about the Shephard Fairey art work on the wall at the corner of Shawmut and Rutland. Susan and Fritz, the owners of the home, explained how they worked with the Institute of Contemporary Art to install the art which is made with paper and applied with wheat paste. Their contact at the BRA said that the work is complient with local historical rules because it is temporary and removable. There are objections to the installation of the art work from members of the Neighborhood Association. There will be further discussion at the March meeting.

The group then proceeded to the Blackstone Community Center. Jose Rodriguez, a member of the staff, gave a tour of the facilities. The building has classrooms used for tutoring, after-school programs, and GED classes. They have a gymnasium, a swimming pool, and meeting rooms, all available to be used by neighbors.
