BACKGROUND

The Blackstone/Franklin Square Neighborhood Association is a non-profit community organization committed to enhancing the quality of life within our community.

As part of our mission to support our neighborhood — the South End — BFSNA provides scholarships for neighborhood high school seniors or current undergraduate students pursuing a higher education.

While many other scholarships cover only tuition, this will aid in covering the cost of books, computers, supplies and miscellaneous fees. Scholarship recipients can choose how to allocate their scholarship.

We invite applications from students living or attending school in the area defined by:

- Southwest Corridor (North) to Albany Street (South)
- Herald Street (East) to Camden Street (West)

In addition, students who are actively involved in a South End community organization but who live outside the South End boundaries are welcome to apply, with scholarships awarded as funds allow. Scholarships of \$1000 are also available to students who have received scholarships in prior years, as funds allow.
